Here is a charming little restaurant in the heart of the West Village that serves satisfying food at very reasonable prices. I am not usually a fan of outdoor dining, but in nice weather, this place is very pleasant – it also gets very crowded on weekends, so be prepared to wait up to twenty minutes for a table if you want to have brunch.

Standout dishes here include a traditional yet tasty spinach salad; Greek salad; gyros; skirt steak and eggs (with potatoes that are actually worth eating); and a gorgeous tuna salad platter served with hard boiled eggs, potato salad, olives, lettuce, and tomato that is a steal for \$8.50. I'm very picky about tuna salad but the Bus Stop uses good quality solid white tuna with just the right amount of celery and mayo.

All portions are generous, the service is friendly and efficient, and the location can't be beat. What more could you ask for these days?
