### **One of the Best Chinese Restaurants in Manhattan**

This chain of Manhattan Chinese restaurants offers some of the best food of its kind in the city. I frequent the Seventh Avenue South location known as Empire Szechuan Village. The food is great, service efficient, and they offer a great lunch special as well (\$6.45 for soup, egg roll, rice, and entrée).

My favorite dish here, without question, is shredded pork with garlic sauce. This dish appears on many Chinese menus but never have I had it done as perfectly as it is here – spicy, flavorful, and loaded with tender pork loin, crisp celery, and water chestnuts. Delicious! Lobster with anything is also a great bet, and much more affordable than many other restaurants like this. Oddly enough, their wonton soup is below par with tiny, thin-skinned wontons that are more like dumplings than wontons. Go for the egg drop or hot and sour instead.

A few years back, they started serving Japanese food as well. The restaurant boasts a very good sushi bar with all of the typical sushi choices.

Whether it's takeout, delivery, a quick lunch or leisurely dinner, Empire Szechuan is sure to satisfy your Chinese food cravings.
